
A/V Equipment: Internet, Video calling; Hybrid option: Zoom link to follow **Recommended Hotels**: (1) <u>Hyatt Place Newark Main Street</u>, 94 EAST MAIN STREET, Newark, DE, US. This hotel is right next to UD campus and next to multiple restaurants. 10 min walk to the Robinson Hall. Walk either along the Academy Street or along the Green (UD's central grassland) to south, you'll see the Robson Hall.

(2) <u>SpringHill Suites Newark Downtown</u> is about 20 min walk to the Robinson Hall. <u>Check here for other hotels</u>

Parking: Perkins Garage (401 Academy Street, Newark, DE; parking pay booth is on the first floor when you exit the garage to Academy Street; then across the Academy Street and walk 3 min, and cross the Green, you will see the Robinson Hall).

Nearest Airport: Philadelphia Airport (PHL) (with shuttle service to Newark, Delaware); BWI (south of DE) is another choice though probably no shuttle.
